

## **WORLD CLASS** PORT COMPLEX

Tanger Med is a global logistics hub, located on the Strait of Gibraltar, second crossing point of world trade on global scale, at the crossroads of major maritime routes East / West and North / South with more than 100 000 ships transiting annually.

Tanger Med is a gateway bridging Europe and Africa, distant by 14 km, thanks to the dedicated trucks and passengers port for import-export activities.

More than a port, Tanger Med port complex is an integrated platform, connected to a multimodal transport network, including truck, train and container flows as well as a highway for the transport of goods and passengers.

Tanger Med constitues a logistics hub for international players aiming to optimize their logistics network for exports and regional distribution and addressing Europe, Africa and
