

COMMISSIONING OF THE "AL BOUGHAZ" LIFEBOAT AT TANGER MED PORT COMPLEX





On May 22^{nd} , the Minister of Agriculture, Maritime Fisheries, Rural Development, and Water and Forests, Mr. Mohamed Sadiki, presided over the commissioning ceremony of the new deep-sea lifeboat, named "Al Boughaz", at Tanger Med Port Complex.

The ceremony was attended by Mr. Fouad Brini, Chairman of Tanger Med Group, Mr. Abdelkhalek Marzouki, Governor of the Fahs-Anjra province, and representatives of national rescue partners and elected officials.

The unit, 21 meters long and built by a Spanish shippard for 25 million MAD, features considerable self-sufficiency and a vast operational range. It reinforces the national maritime search and rescue system at sea, offering increased response capacity in the Strait of Gibraltar, an area characterized by dense maritime traffic.

Assigned to Tanger Med Port Complex, this vessel is equipped to meet the specific needs of the region, with greater self-sufficiency at sea. It is part of a response system coordinated by the National Maritime Rescue Coordination Center (MRCC Rabat), aiming to improve the responsiveness, efficiency, and rationalization of national resources.

This system, led by experts in search and rescue coordination within the context of a national, regional, and local organization, enables Morocco, as a coastal state, to meet its obligations in terms of rescue at sea, in accordance with national and international regulations in force.

The ceremony also saw the signing of a partnership agreement between the Ministry of Agriculture, Maritime Fisheries, Rural Development, and Water and Forests and Tanger Med Port Authority. The aim of the agreement is to support maritime rescue operations and ensure greater efficiency and speed in rescue operations in the Strait of Gibraltar region, where many commercial vessels and passengers pass through.

PORT OF NADOR WEST MED

MARSA MAROC TO OPERATE THE EAST CONTAINER TERMINAL



Marsa Maroc and Nador West Med have signed the concession agreement for the Nador West Med East Container Terminal, with a capacity of 3.4 million Twenty-Foot Equivalent Units (TEU). The Supervisory Board meeting of Marsa Maroc, on June 25^{th} , 2024, authorized the signing of the concession documents for the East Container Terminal at the Port of Nador West Med (NWM), for a period of 25 years.

The new terminal, with 1,520 linear meters of quay, a depth of 18 meters, and 70 hectares of open space, will handle 3.4 million TEU at full capacity, and will be equipped with 15 state-of-the-art quay gantry cranes (STS) and 45 state-of-the-art yard gantry cranes (RTG). Marsa Maroc will invest 200 million euros to build the first phase of the terminal, commissioning is scheduled in 2027. Building on its experience in container transshipment since January 2021 at Tanger Med Port Complex, where it operates Container Terminal 3 (TC3) in partnership with Hapag Lloyd, Eurogate International GmbH, and Contship Italia S.p.A., the operator intends to reinforce its leadership in the national and Mediterranean market. TC3 reached its full capacity of 1.5 million TEU just three years after commissioning. With this new terminal, Marsa Maroc will increase its container handling capacity to 6.5 million TEUs, including almost 5 million TEUs for transshipment.

PARTICIPATION IN THE AFRICA CEO FORUM IN KIGALI



At the 11th annual Africa CEO Forum summit, held in Kigali on May 16th and 17th, 2024, 2,000 business leaders, CEOs, investors, heads of state, and ministers gathered to discuss strategies for strengthening Africa's position. The emphasis was placed on exploiting the continent's comparative advantages, such as demographic growth, the development of natural resources, and the entertainment sector. This summit was an interesting opportunity to define a new trajectory and meet future challenges.

Tanger Med Group participated in a session under the theme "Green ports, blue oceans: Accelerating decarbonization in the maritime industry", as well as a strategic roundtable under the theme "Navigating digital waters: Preparing African ports for a single maritime window".

These sessions highlighted Tanger Med's initiatives in decarbonization and digitalization of ports, thus contributing to the modernization and sustainability of the African maritime sector.

The event was marked by Tanger Med Group's participation. Tanger Med Port Authority and Marsa Maroc were actively involved in this key event for industry professionals.

PARTICIPATION IN THE 16TH EDITION OF SIAM IN MEKNÈS



Tanger Med was an exhibitor at the 16th edition of the International Agricultural Expo in Morocco (SIAM), held in Meknes from April 22nd - 28th, 2024. The objective was to present its port and logistics offerings for national imports and exports. This year, with Spain in the spotlight, Tanger Med has invited representatives of partner Spanish port authorities operating direct maritime links for import-export traffic, notably the ports of Algeciras, Motril, and Barcelona, to run the exhibition booth. The objective was to strengthen cooperative links between the ports by presenting a common value proposition for the transport of goods to operators. In addition, a presentation was held at Tanger Med's booth on Tuesday April 23rd, from 2 pm to 3 pm, with the Spanish ports invited, focusing on the theme of "A valuable logistics offer for flows between Morocco and Spain".

IPCSA ANNUAL MEETING HELD AT TANGER MED PORT COMPLEX



Innovation, artificial intelligence, supply chain resilience, and cybersecurity were among the main topics addressed by members of the International Port Community Systems Association (IPCSA) at their annual two-day meeting, hosted by Tanger Med Port Authority on May 15th–16th.

Operators of port community systems and one-stop service centers from all over the world took part in the meeting, which incorporated both regional and global perspectives.

The agenda featured discussions on sustainability and cybersecurity, as well as sessions led by members of IPCSA's African region, who presented an overview of their operations and innovations.

THE IHMA HOLDS ITS 14TH ANNUAL CONGRESS AT TANGER MED PORT COMPLEX





In partnership with the IHMA (International Harbour Master Association), Tanger Med organized the fourteenth edition of the Harbour Masters Congress at Tanger Med Port Center on May 21^{st} – 23^{rd} , 2024. Considered a key international event for discussing maritime and port issues, IHMA congresses are held every 2 years in the world's main trading ports. The last one was held in 2022 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

The opening ceremony was attended by the Managing Director of Tanger Med Port Authority, Mr. Hassan ABKARI, the President of IHMA, Mr. Paul O'REGAN, the Director of Ports and Maritime Affairs, Mrs. Sanae El AMRANI, Tanger Med's Harbour Master, Mr. Kamal LAKHMAS, and other harbour masters.

This not-to-be-missed event brought together almost 200 foreign participants, including 33 African port authorities, to promote exchanges, debates as well as strengthen professional networks. A rich and informative three-day program was also provided. IHMA also highlighted the latest innovations in port call optimization, smart ports, technology, digitalization, artificial intelligence, real-time data, the transition of pilotage systems into the future, developments in mooring and port infrastructure, as well as harbour masters in safety and incident management.

LAUNCH OF MARHABA OPERATION 2024: PREPARATIONS AND REINFORCED MEASURES



As part of the launch of Operation Marhaba 2024 on June 5th, Tanger Med Passenger Port has mobilized all its resources to welcome Moroccans living abroad in the most efficient and comfortable conditions, under the supervision of the Mohammed V Foundation for Solidarity.

For this 2024 campaign, Tanger Med Port Authority has allocated a budget of 40 million MAD to improve port infrastructure and passenger services. Improvements included more shaded areas and dynamic display screens, more food and beverage locations, improved signage in the terminal, a new public address system, and services for people with special needs.

As for the shipping lines operating during the campaign, the Merchant Marine Division has expanded the fleet operating between Tanger Med and Algeciras to 12 vessels, with a capacity of over 40,000 passengers and 11,000 vehicles per day. Night ferries provide services to Motril and Barcelona in Spain, Genoa in Italy, Sète and Marseille in France, with an additional weekly capacity of 12,000 passengers and 5,000 vehicles.

A range of communication tools are available to support passengers during this operation, including the passenger port website, mobile app, social media, and Tanger Med Radio on 100 FM.

Under the overall coordination of the Mohammed V Foundation for Solidarity, all those involved in the Marhaba Operation, including the DGSN, the national police (Gendarmerie), Customs Office, auxiliary forces, the Ministry of Health, and local authorities, were fully mobilized to guarantee a smooth passage for Moroccans around the world.

ORGANIZATION OF THE "PORTS AND RENEWABLE ENERGIES" WORKSHOP WITH UAPNA AT TANGER MED PORT COMPLEX



In accordance with the Union des Administrations Portuaires du Nord de l'Afrique (UAPNA) roadmap, resulting from the decisions of its Council at its forty-second session held on September 26th, 2023, a workshop on the theme "Ports and renewable energies" was organized from June 27th to 28th, 2024, at Tanger Med Port Complex. The workshop brought together representatives of Union members from Libya, the Islamic Republic of Mauritania, and the Republic of Sudan, as well as Morocco, represented by Tanger Med Port Authority and the National Ports Agency. Representatives of the Arab Republic of Egypt and those of Tunisia's Nefza Port Company took part via videoconference.

The organization of this workshop is part of the Union's proactive and practical approach to monitoring current developments in the port sector in relation to energy transition and sustainable development, with the goal of transforming the Union's ports into green, environmentally-friendly ones. During the workshop, after presentations by representatives of the National Ports Agency and Tanger Med Port Authority of the Kingdom of Morocco, and the discussions that followed, participants examined all aspects and issues related to the subject, and formulated conclusions and recommendations applicable to the Union's ports to capitalize on renewable energies, a major challenge for ports today.

ORGANIZATION OF MARINE POLLUTION RESPONSE SIMULATION EXERCISES



On April 26th and 27th, 2024, the Port's Harbour Master's Office organized a series of accidental marine pollution simulation exercises in the Port's anchorage area and basins.

These simulations involved the participation of various equipment and teams: the Port's MARPOL barge, a tugboat, a mooring launch, the Port's Safety and Response Officers, and the Port Safety Brigade team. Three experts from the French Center for Documentation, Research, and Experimentation on Accidental Water Pollution (CEDRE) were also present.

CEDRE experts tested and inspected the Port Authority's anti-pollution equipment, as part of the Intervention and Technical Assistance Agreement between TMPA and this center of expertise in marine pollution preparedness and response.

OPEN HOUSE DAYS: FNIDEQ ACTIVITY ZONE PRESENTS ITSELF TO RETAILERS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC



The 2^{nd} edition of the Fnideq Economic Activity Zone (ZAEF) Open House was held from May 23^{rd} to 28^{th} , under the theme "ZAEF: A commercial and developmental driver for the region".

Organized by the Tangier-Tetouan-Al Hoceima Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Services (CCIS-TTA), in collaboration with the ZAEF Investors Association, this economic event continued the objectives of the successful first edition, aimed at promoting investors in the region and boosting job creation.

The event highlighted the importance of ZAEF and the many investment advantages it offers. It encouraged economic operators to work more closely with local and regional traders in order to facilitate large-scale marketing of their products on regional markets.

The first section of the 10-hectare ZAEF already accommodates 76 warehouses ranging from 200 to 400 m^2 , representing a wide range of sectors including agri-food, textiles and clothing, electronics and hygiene products, home furnishings, and more.

This project, representing an innovative economic initiative, had met with significant success. The merchants in attendance enjoyed a host of perks and benefits, as well as the support of ZAEF teams and the relevant administrations, including the Indirect Tax and Customs Administration (ADII), the Wilaya of Tangier, Tetouan, and Al Hoceima, the Ministry of Industry and Trade, the Agency for the Promotion and Development of the North, the Regional Investment Center, the Chamber of Commerce and the M'diq-Fnideq Prefecture.

SET UPS IN THE MEDHUB LOGISTICS PLATFORM

ORDINARY AND EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETINGS SCHEDULED FOR JUNE 25TH, 2024



The Ordinary and Extraordinary General Shareholders' Meetings of Marsa Maroc - Port Operating Company (Société d'Exploitation des Ports) - were held on June 25th, 2024 at the Company's corporate headquarters.

The Ordinary General Shareholders' Meeting, convened at 10:30 a.m., following presentation of the Board of Directors' management report and the Statutory Auditors' reports, approved the financial statements for the year ending December 31st, 2023, as presented by the Board of Directors.

The meeting also approved the distribution of a dividend of 8.5 MAD per share. The dividend will be payable starting August 7^{th} , 2024.

The Extraordinary General Shareholders' Meeting held at 11 a.m., having taken note of the Board of Directors' proposal to change the Company's method of administration and management, decided that Marsa Maroc will no longer have a Supervisory Board and Board of Directors, but will henceforth be administered by an Executive Board.

The Extraordinary General Shareholders' Meeting also decided to transfer the Company's registered office from its current address to "Angle Boulevard Route d'El Jadida et Rue les Papillons, Casablanca".

To reflect these changes, the Extraordinary General Shareholders' Meeting adopted the Company's new bylaws. In addition, following the change in the Company's corporate governance structure to that of a public limited company with an Executive Board, the Annual General Shareholders' Meeting held at 11:30 a.m. noted the termination of the functions of the members of the Supervisory Board and the members of the Board of Directors, and made the following appointments:

On April 6^{th} , 2024, Marsa Maroc handled the first fuel oil vessel at berth 8 in the port of Jorf Lasfar. This first shipment was successfully unloaded thanks to the new pipelines commissioned at the Port. The forecast for this new traffic is 120 KT for the start-up year.

TANGER MED PORT

NEW TRAFFIC AT THE BULK AND GENERAL CARGO TERMINAL



On April 30th, 2024, Tanger Med's Bulk and General Cargo Terminal processed a 5,000T vessel of bulk sand from Spain. The shipment, which was shipped directly from Tangier, is destined for the redevelopment of the city's soccer stadium in preparation for the 2025 African Cup and the 2030 World Cup.

PORT OF DAKHLA

UNLOADING AN EXCEPTIONALLY HEAVY PARCEL



On April 25th, 2024, the Multipurpose Terminal at the Port of Dakhla welcomed the unloading of an exceptionally heavy parcel from the Port of Saint-Nazaire. This parcel, an automated kite sail system called Seawing, is intended for sail propulsion on commercial vessels and aims to reduce carbon emissions in shipping thanks to sustainable technologies. Owned by the French company Airseas, a subsidiary of the Japanese Group K Line, this system will be installed on a windy R&D site in Dakhla (Route Aargoub) to test the sails.

PORT OF SAFI

BOOMING BULK GYPSUM TRAFFIC



Bulk gypsum traffic has become an important activity at the Port of Safi, with export volumes rising steadily over the past five years, from 700 KT in 2019 to almost 1.5 MT in 2023. In May 2024, the team from the Port of Safi Operations Department paid a technical visit to the LAFARGE PLACO Morocco plant to gain a better understanding of the product, its production process, and safety standards. The plant, an affiliate of Saint-Gobain and LafargeHolcim, is mainly involved in the production of gypsum and its derivatives. The visit provided an opportunity to discuss future market developments and adapt Marsa Maroc's offering to meet customer needs.

DOCKING A NEWLY-BUILT BULK CARRIER

On May $20^{\rm th}$, 2024, the vessel SANTA VENERA, a bulk carrier delivered in March 2024 and sailing under the Maltese flag, docked at the Port of Safi. This was the third port of call for this ship equipped with the latest navigation technology, which has loaded more than 27 KT of fertilizer and feed in big bags for export. Passage through the mandatory pilotage zone and subsequent berthing were handled by pilots from the Port of Safi's Operations Department.

Digitization

ISO 27001: RENEWAL AND SUCCESSFUL TRANSITION TO THE 2022 VERSION

Tanger Med successfully made the transition to the new version of ISO 27001 during its renewal audit. The ISO/IEC 27001:2022 version responds to the new challenges facing businesses, particularly in the fields of cybersecurity and personal data protection. Key changes include:

- The introduction of digital technologies such as the Cloud and automation
- Increased adoption of these technologies
- Recognition of the risks associated with cybersecurity and personal data
- The integration of evolutions in the threat landscape, including new types of malware and ransomware
- Alignment with other best practices, such as those of NIST (National Institute of Standards and Technology) and COBIT (Control Objectives for Information and Related Technology)
- Updated control language and additional tips.

TRAINING FOR AMSSNUR



A training session was organized for employees of the Moroccan Agency for Nuclear and Radiological Safety and Security (AMSSNUR) on the module for managing requests for transit of nuclear (Class 7) and radioactive materials. This module, integrated into the Tanger Med Port Community System, enables transit requests to be processed electronically. It is used to digitally compile the application file, submit it to the Tanger Med Port Harbour Master's Office for advice and confirmation, and then forward it to AMSSNUR for validation or rejection. The module also generates letters of completion, transit authorizations, and inspection reports.

DIGITAL TWINS AND PREDICTIVE MAINTENANCE: A MAJOR ADVANCEMENT FOR TANGER MED



As part of its efforts to stay at the forefront of innovation, Tanger Med's Digitalization Team has launched a proof-of-concept (PoC) project in collaboration with TMPA's Maintenance Team, TME's Asset Management Department, and PHD Soft, a developer of digital twins solutions for the maritime sector. The goal of this project is to create a digital representation of the TM2 Link Bridge, also known as the Houar Bridge at Tanger Med, to facilitate predictive and automated maintenance.

The project saw the active involvement of all parties concerned, who focused their efforts on several key aspects:

- Maintenance Inspection Digitalization and Automation: The solution's ability to transform manual maintenance processes into more efficient digital procedures was analyzed. This includes real-time data collection and analysis for optimized asset management.
- Failure Mode Prediction: The use of advanced algorithms to anticipate potential asset failures was a key focus of the valuation. This feature will optimize maintenance operations and improve equipment longevity.
- Automated Information Flows: The solution aims to automate data collection and processing, facilitating decision-making and the continuous improvement of maintenance processes.
- Alignment with the TME Asset Management Department Roadmap: The project was also assessed for its fit with Tanger Med's strategic asset management objectives, ensuring seamless integration with existing and future initiatives.

This project is based on cutting-edge technologies such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), Machine Learning (ML), and the Internet of Things (IoT). Thanks to these innovations, Tanger Med continues to strengthen its position as a leader in port infrastructure management and continuous improvement of operations.

By implementing this digital twins solution, Tanger Med is positioning itself as a key player in the digital transformation of the maritime sector, paving the way for more reliable predictive maintenance and optimized asset management. This initiative promises not only to improve operational efficiency, but also to extend the lifespan of critical infrastructures.

PROJECT CIPHER: A STEP TOWARDS OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE



The second quarter kicked off with the launch (kick-off) of Pilot Project 3, dubbed "Project Cipher", a collaborative initiative between TMPA, the Port of Rotterdam, and the Tanger Med ecosystem aimed at reducing documentation errors and optimizing operations at Tanger Med thanks to digital solutions.

At the heart of this project, several key partners played a crucial role:

- Puerto Transit : Providing transit services, they ensured the seamless management of documents and shipments
- Driscolls: As exporters, they worked closely together to ensure document accuracy.
- Partida Logística : Acting as forwarding agents in Spain, they facilitated cross-border transit with increased efficiency.
- · CSI Fresh: Providing essential logistical support, their participation was crucial to the success of the project.

By the end of the second quarter, the objectives of this pilot had been successfully achieved. The documentation error rate has been reduced to 0% on 218 shipments. This avoided a 15-hour delay at port entry, thanks to error-free packing lists, phytosanitary certificates, and Foodex.

The eDox Online digital solution was a major asset for this project. Thanks to this advanced technology, it has been possible to automate and secure documentation processes, guaranteeing unprecedented fluidity and accuracy.

The success of this pilot project marks an important step for Tanger Med in its quest for operational excellence. By continuing to exploit digital technologies and collaborating with dedicated partners, we are certain that these high standards will be maintained and surpassed in future operations.

LAUNCH OF CONSTRUCTION WORK FOR THE BTR MEDITERRANEAN NEW MATERIAL MANUFACTURING PLANT



Construction work has begun on the BTR Mediterranean New Material manufacturing plant, which specializes in the production of cathodes for electric batteries. The new BTR Mediterranean New Material plant is designed to boost production capacity for cathodes, an essential component in electric batteries. 

The candidates can be proud of how far they have come thanks to their sustained efforts over the past two years. There's just one last hurdle to clear: the oral interviews, which will determine their final admission to these prestigious institutions.
