NADOR WEST MED: WMCT RECEIVES FIRST BATCH OF LATEST GENERATION STS GANTRIES

West Med Container Terminal (WMCT) received a first batch of three Super Post-Panamax container cranes.

Designed to handle the largest container ships, this equipment marks the beginning of the operational deployment of the East Terminal, which is scheduled to begin operations in the final quarter of 2026.



TMPA JOINS FORCES WITH ANP TO DEPLOY NATIONAL FOREIGN TRADE PROCEDURES PORTAL

Tanger Med Port Authority (TMPA) has formed a partnership with the National Ports Agency (ANP) around PortNet, with a view to deploying a strategic national infrastructure: the National Foreign Trade Procedures Portal.

This project aims to simplify and streamline the administrative processes of economic operators, by reducing processing times, optimizing transaction costs and improving service quality, in response to the growing demands of international trade and for the facilitation of import/export operations.

It aligns with a system convergence approach, aiming to ensure fluid, consistent, and interoperable integration with existing digital systems,



particularly the services offered by the various Port Community Systems (PCS) of Tanger Med and the ANP.

TMPA will actively contribute alongside the ANP across all phases of the project, from strategic design to operational implementation.

In this framework, TMPA's Board of Directors met and authorized a equity stake of MAD 285 million in the capital of PortNet, allowing it to hold a 44% share in the company, alongside the ANP.

Ultimately, this initiative aims to provide the Kingdom with an integrated, efficient and sovereign digital platform, serving all foreign trade stakeholders, while strengthening Morocco's position as a leading logistics and digital hub at the regional and continental level.

COMMISSIONING OF AFRICA'S LARGEST FLOATING SOLAR POWER PLANT

Renewable energy production takes another step forward with the commissioning of the floating photovoltaic power plant at the Oued Rmel dam. With an installed capacity of 13 MWp deployed across nearly 8 hectares, it becomes the largest floating solar power plant currently operating on the African continent.

Constructed on a site presenting specific technical constraints—notably complex bank topography and seasonal dam water level variations ranging between 35 and 79 meters—the facility relies on a modular floating structure and an elastic anchoring system to ensure its stability under all conditions.

With an annual electricity production of 20 GWh, this plant covers approximately 10% of the port's energy needs and reinforces the self-generation component of the Group's energy strategy. It serves as an additional lever toward achieving the carbon neutrality target by 2030



for all Tanger Med operations, while contributing to the national initiative targeting 52% of renewable energy in the Moroccan power mix by the same deadline.

Beyond its contribution to renewable energy production, the plant provides an additional environmental benefit: by covering a portion of the water surface,

the floating panels help limit reservoir evaporation by up to an estimated 30%. This solution thus helps preserve a strategic water resource, in a context marked by water stress.

PARTICIPATION IN EVENTS

GITEX AFRICA 2026

From April 7 to 9, 2026, the 4th edition of GITEX AFRICA Morocco, the continent's largest tech exhibition, was held in Marrakech. Tanger Med Group took part in this edition alongside its technology subsidiary Cires Technologies, a joint presence that highlighted the digital solutions developed by the Group to drive port, logistics, and industrial performance.

Centered around the theme "Catalyzing Africa's Digital Economy in the Age of Artificial Intelligence," this edition provided Cires Technologies with a natural platform to solidify its role as a leading technology player in cybersecurity, data management, and digital sovereignty.



This 4th edition of GITEX Africa Morocco brought together more than 55 000 visitors, 1 500 exhibitors from 58 countries and 412 investors.

Through its participation, Tanger Med Group reaffirms its commitment to innovation and digital transformation, as well as its determination to support technological momentum across Africa and beyond.

Themed "Resilience, Innovation, and Alliances: The Drivers of Spanish-Moroccan Automotive Cooperation," the 11th Spanish-Moroccan Automotive Industry Meeting was held on April 22 and 23, 2026, at the Barceló Hotel in Tangier, under the initiative of the Official Chamber of Commerce of Spain in Morocco.

2026 AFRICAN PORTS FORUM

From May 19 to 21, 2026, Accra (Ghana) hosted the African Ports Forum, a continental event bringing together key players in the port, maritime and logistics sectors to discuss governance, competitiveness, digitization, and sustainable development of African port infrastructure.

Represented by TMPA, Marsa Maroc, Tanger Med Engineering (TME) and CIRES, Tanger Med Group took part in the various conferences and round tables dedicated to the development prospects of African ports. Represented by several of its senior executives, TMPA actively contributed to the discussions of this inaugural edition through two presentations.

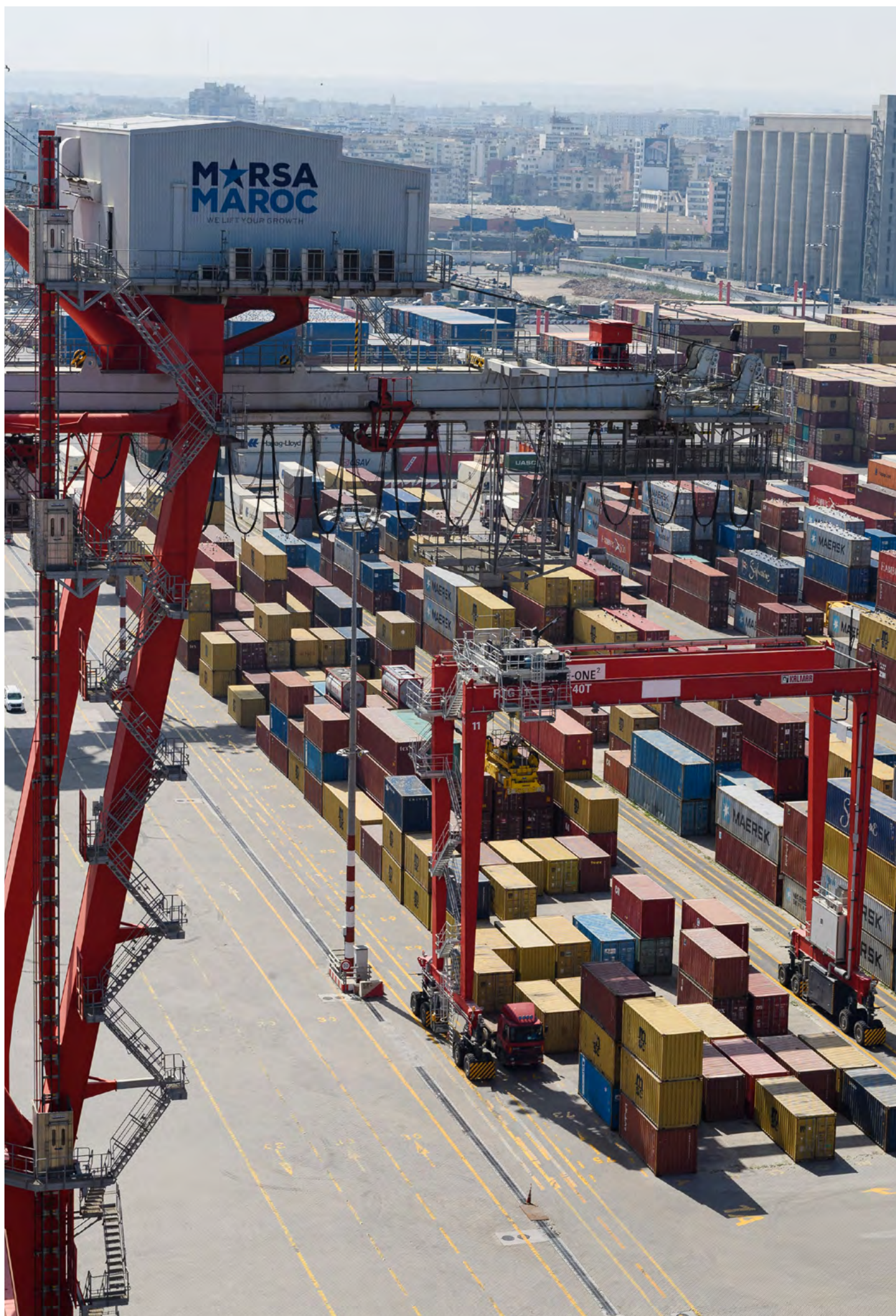

ARRIVAL OF COSUMAR GROUP'S FIRST LARGE-CAPACITY VESSEL AT PORT OF CASABLANCA'S MULTIPURPOSE TERMINAL



Marsa Maroc's multipurpose terminal at the Port of Casablanca welcomed its first large-capacity vessel following the commissioning of the first phase

of the dredging works. A 200-meter sugar bulk carrier chartered by the Cosumar Group, carrying 55 000 tons of raw sugar, was able to berth thanks

to the new 12-meter draft, realizing the immediate benefits of the project.

PORT OF CASABLANCA: COMMISSIONING OF 230 LINEAR METERS OF DEEPEMED QUAY

Marsa Maroc has commissioned 230 linear meters of quay deepened to -12 meters. This upgrade enables the terminal to handle vessels of up to 60 000 tons, driving down logistics costs and boosting operational efficiency for its customers.

funded by the EBRD to support the improvement of the port's capacity.

PORT OF CASABLANCA: FLEET REINFORCEMENT WITH 3 REACH STACKERS AND 4 FORKLIFTS

Marsa Maroc has reinforced its equipment fleet with the commissioning of three reach stackers and four front-loading forklifts within the Casablanca Port Operations Directorate, dedicated to container and Ro-Ro activities. This investment will strengthen the operational capabilities of the terminals, while improving their performance, productivity, and quality of service.

LAUNCH OF ONE'S NEW MAX SERVICE TO WEST AFRICA



The Japanese shipping company Ocean Network Express (ONE) announced the launch of its new weekly Mediterranean Africa Express (MAX) service, strengthening Tanger Med's connectivity with major West African markets.

The service will operate the following rotation: Algeciras – Tanger Med – Dakar – Tema – Lekki (Lagos) – Abidjan – Algeciras, with the first port call scheduled in Algeciras on July 7, 2026.

NEW MAERSK SERVICE BETWEEN MEDITERRANEAN AND BALTIC SEA

Maersk has integrated Tanger Med into its new weekly SLA Baltic Sea service, strengthening the Moroccan hub's connectivity with major Mediterranean and Baltic Sea ports.

Operated by a fleet of five container ships with a capacity of 4 000 to 5 000 TEUs, this service operates a 35-day rotation linking Gdańsk, Bremerhaven, Vado Ligure, Port Said, Alexandria, and Tanger Med. It offers a transit time of approximately 10 days between Tanger Med and Gdańsk and 1 day between Tanger Med and Alexandria, thereby consolidating trade between the western and eastern Mediterranean, as well as with the Baltic Sea.

REORGANIZATION OF X-PRESS FEEDERS' MEDITERRANEAN NETWORK

Singapore-based operator X-Press Feeders has reorganized its Mediterranean network by merging its CTX service with the Tyrrhenian X-Press (TYX NB). This development strengthens Tanger Med's role as a regional hub, with the integration of a new rotation linking Algeciras – Tanger Med – Milazzo – Salerno – Naples – Algeciras.

The service is operated by a fleet of two container ships with a capacity ranging between 1775 and 1800 TEUs, improving connectivity between Tanger Med and the main ports of the Mediterranean basin.

GNV AURORA MAKES MAIDEN CALL AT PASSENGER AND RO-RO PORT



On May 29, 2026, the Passenger and Ro-Ro Port welcomed the maiden call of the GNV Aurora to mark its inaugural voyage within the GNV fleet.

The GNV Aurora is the second vessel of a new generation of ferries powered by Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG). It is also equipped with Cold Ironing technology, which allows the auxiliary engines to be shut off at berth and supplies the vessel with electricity from the onshore grid. This solution contributes to the reduction of atmospheric emissions as well as noise pollution during port calls.

ORGANIZATION OF SERIES OF JOINT EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DRILLS

During the second quarter of 2026, seven joint emergency preparedness drills were organized with port concessionaires and operators across several strategic facilities within the port complex, including container terminals, the general cargo terminal, the hydrocarbon storage area, the port reception facility for hydrocarbon waste (SERTEGO), and the Passenger and Ro-Ro port expansion site.

These drills aimed to strengthen the operational readiness of teams, test communication, coordination,

evacuation, and intervention asset deployment protocols, improve response times during emergencies, and evaluate the operational capabilities of the Safety Brigade along with the performance of its equipment.

The drills were conducted within two complementary frameworks:

- Three drills to maintain proficiency and reinforce the skills of the Safety Brigade, focusing specifically on high-angle evacuation and firefighting scenarios at the HTTSA facilities,

terminal TC2, and the SERTEGO facility;

- Three drills organized to mark World Safety Day, carried out across terminals TC1 and TC4 and the general cargo terminal.

The training sequence concluded with an underwater diving and salvage drill utilizing lift bags, conducted on May 8, 2026, at the passenger and Ro-Ro port expansion facility.



IMPLEMENTATION OF EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SURVEILLANCE AND MONITORING SYSTEM AGAINST RISK OF HANTAVIRUS INTRODUCTION

Following reports by competent international health authorities of Hantavirus contamination cases aboard a cruise ship, the Local Port Committee met on May 7, 2026, at the Harbor Master's Office to establish reinforced vigilance and epidemiological surveillance measures.

In this context, several preventive measures have been deployed, including strengthening the sanitary inspection of ships, with particular attention paid to rodent control devices at mooring lines, strengthening the traceability of crew changes on ships in port, as well as

carrying out a general rat extermination campaign across all port facilities.

PARTICIPATION IN EVENTS

SIAM 2026

From April 21 to 27, 2026, Tanger Med participated in the 17th edition of the International Exhibition of Agriculture in Morocco (SIAM), held in Meknes under the theme: "Agriculture and the Rural World: Water at the Heart of Sustainable Development."

Through its presence at this benchmark event, TMPA highlighted the logistics and port solutions developed to support the agricultural and agri-food sectors, facilitating operators' access to international markets thanks to premium maritime connectivity and integrated logistics services.



This participation also provided a prime opportunity to meet with institutional and economic stakeholders in the sector, discuss competitiveness challenges in agricultural supply chains, and reaffirm Tanger Med's commitment

to trade development and logistics performance in service of the national economy.

INAUGURAL NATIONAL MARITIME SUMMIT

On May 21 and 22, 2026, Tangier hosted the Inaugural National Maritime Summit, a major event organized under the theme "Morocco, an Emerging Maritime Nation". Bringing together key public institutions, port stakeholders, maritime professionals and national experts, this first edition provided a strategic framework for reflection on the major orientations of the Kingdom's maritime policy, logistics competitiveness, energy transition, and the governance of maritime activities.

On this occasion, Idriss Aarabi, Managing Director of Tanger Med Port Authority, spoke during the panel dedicated to maritime logistics as a lever for economic, industrial, and commercial competitiveness. His presentation highlighted Tanger Med's structural role in developing



national and international logistics chains, emphasizing the importance of maritime connectivity, intermodality, and the integration of port, industrial, and logistics operations to support the Kingdom's economic ambitions.

The work also addressed issues related to maritime safety and security, environmental transition, innovation and skills development, all essential levers for building a more resilient

and sustainable maritime sector. In this framework, Kamal Lakhmas, Port Captain and Harbor Master Office Director at Tanger Med Port Authority, shared his expertise during the discussions dedicated to navigation safety and maritime domain protection.

The Maritime Silk Road Port Cooperation Forum was held from May 26 to 28, 2026 in Ningbo, China, bringing together more than 1 000 participants from key port, maritime, and logistics players, representing more than 70 countries and regions. This benchmark event constitutes a major international platform for exchanges on the major strategic challenges of the sector, including the resilience of supply chains, the energy transition, port digitization, and the strengthening of global cooperation.

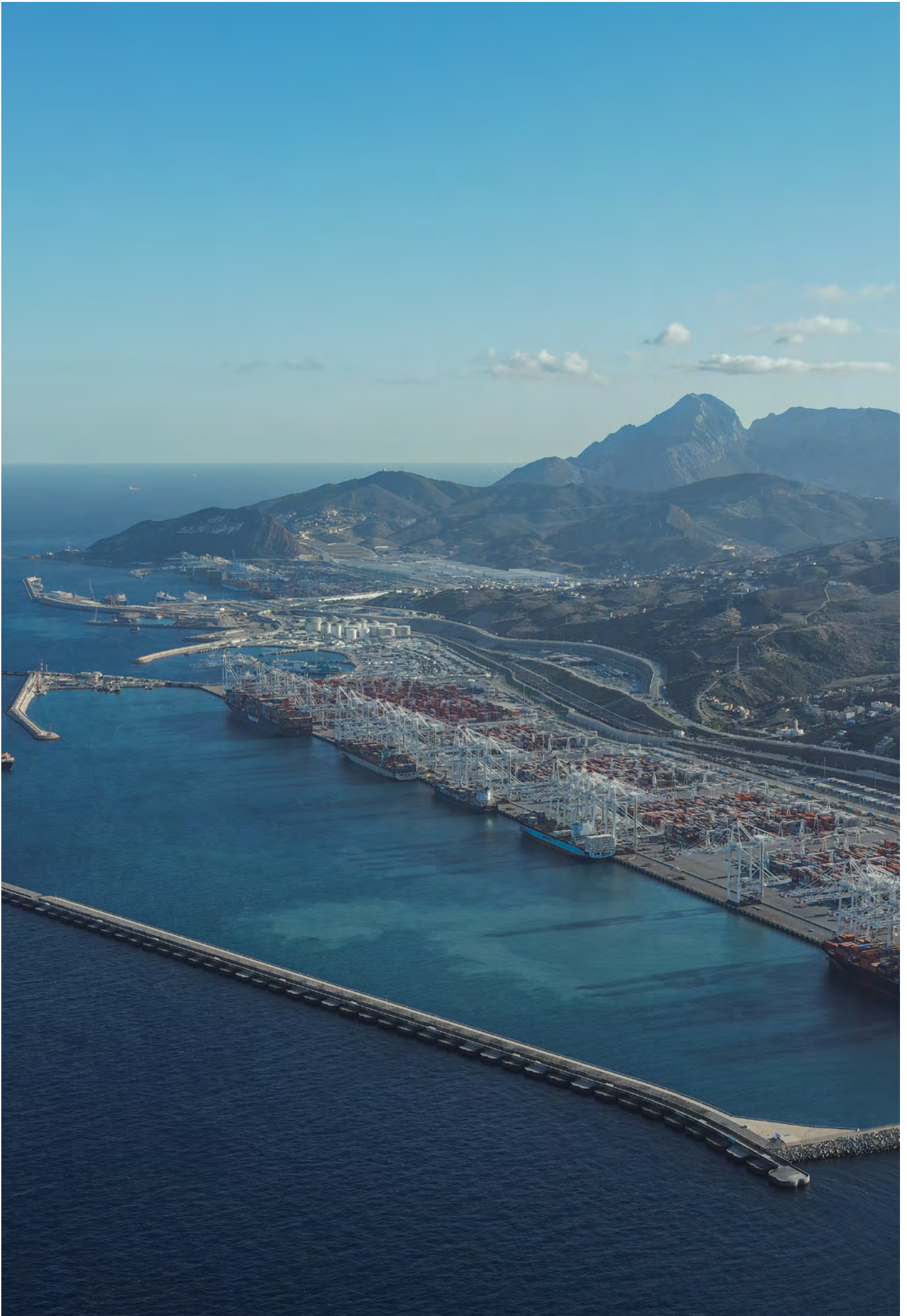

La Voie Express Group and MEDHUB have signed a MOU marking a new stage in their strategic partnership.

The project involves the development of a 10 000 m² infrastructure dedicated to logistics services. This location in a free zone allows customs clearance, storage, and shipping operations to be centralized on a single site. This technical system aims to eliminate breaks in the

supply chain and intermediate transfers, thereby reducing the processing time of goods.

For international freight operators, this organization provides a simplification of processes and increased security for multimodal operations.

MEDHUB CONSOLIDATES ITS ROLE AS GLOBAL LOGISTICS HUB

In 2026, MEDHUB confirms its role as an international logistics platform by strengthening its positioning on global-to-global trade flows. Thanks to extensive connectivity, the platform facilitates trade between major global markets and supports the development of supply chains on an international scale.

This dynamic is reflected in the development of new global logistics flows, with the launch of a project to distribute medical products from Europe to African markets, the establishment of a regional hub dedicated to the distribution of telecom and electronic products to Africa and Eastern Europe, as well as

the development of a new activity for the storage and distribution of food products linking the Middle East to European markets.

TRANSPORT LOGISTIC CHINA EXHIBITION

From June 24 to 26, 2026, MEDHUB participated in the Transport Logistic China 2026 exhibition in Shanghai, a major event for the logistics and transport sector in Asia. SFC AUTOMOTIVE SOLUTIONS INAUGURATES A NEW INDUSTRIAL FACILITY WITHIN THE INDUSTRIAL PLATFORM

Specializing in the design and manufacture of rubber sealing solutions and fluid transfer systems for the automotive industry, SFC Automotive Solutions, a subsidiary of the German investment fund MUTARES, has inaugurated its new industrial unit within Tanger Med's industrial platform.

The ceremony was held in the presence of His Excellency Mr. Karim Zidane, Minister of Investment, Convergence and Evaluation of Public Policies, Mr. Ahmed Bennis, Director General of Tanger Med Zones, as well as the leaders of MUTARES and SFC Automotive Solutions. Located on 6 hectares, this new factory represents an investment of 28 million euros and is expected to create 900 direct jobs. It will produce automotive sealing solutions and fluid transfer systems for thermal, hybrid, and electric vehicles, thus strengthening the automotive ecosystem of Tanger Med's industrial platform.



Alongside this inauguration, Tanger Med Zones and MUTARES signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) aimed at supporting the establishment in Morocco of companies in the portfolio of the German investment fund, which includes more than 40 multinationals.



This partnership aims to promote the development of new industrial projects, particularly in the automotive sector, and to enhance the attractiveness of Tanger Med's industrial platform to German and European investors.

HANDOVER OF STANDARD MODULES 9 AND 10 WITHIN TANGER AUTOMOTIVE CITY

Standard modules 9 and 10, developing a total covered area of approximately 8 500 m², have been delivered at the front of Tanger Automotive City. Now housing the logistics activities of the car manufacturer Renault, these buildings have equipment that meets industrial standards, including dock levelers and

fire protection systems. The larger of the two units offers a surface area of 4 500 m², including nearly 350 m² of office space, complemented by outdoor facilities that feature dedicated minibus parking, maneuvering zones, and green spaces.

TANGER MED ENGINEERING ORGANIZES WORLD-CLASS MARINE ANTI-POLLUTION TRAINING PROGRAM IN PARTNERSHIP WITH CEDRE



From June 8 to 11, 2026, Tanger Med Engineering (TME) organized a specialized training program in marine and port oil spill response at Tanger Med's Port Complex, in partnership with Cedre, a leading French organization in the field of accidental water pollution.

Accredited by the Nautical Institute at the IMO 2 level, this session brought together professionals from across the Moroccan port ecosystem, notably port authorities, terminal operators, oil spill

response teams, as well as companies from the shipping and energy sectors.

For four days, participants alternated between theoretical instruction and operational simulations. After deepening their knowledge of oil behavior in marine environments, they participated in several practical exercises: deploying containment booms, using skimmers and sorbent materials, conducting pollution response operations around a berthed vessel, and shoreline cleanup operations.

Through this initiative, Tanger Med Engineering reaffirms its commitment to sharing best practices and strengthening the skills of national port and maritime actors. By developing a shared culture of prevention and intervention, TME contributes to improving operator preparedness for accidental pollution risks and strengthening the environmental resilience of port infrastructure.

TANGER MED ENGINEERING TRAINS OFFICERS FROM PORT AUTHORITY OF LIMBE

Deployed from June 4 to July 14, 2026, within Tanger Med's Port Complex, this program aims to strengthen the participants' operational skills by leveraging the expertise developed within the leading container port in Africa and the Mediterranean.

The first phase, dedicated to theoretical instruction, took place over four weeks across seven modules: introduction to harbor master office professions, vessel call planning and management, maritime traffic operations and management, port interventions, international regulatory framework for port management, hazardous materials safety and environmental protection, and port security. These courses are supplemented by operational scenario training, fire simulation exercises, and

site visits to facilities dedicated to port security control.

The program will continue with two weeks of practical immersion, from July 1 to July 14, during which the participants will join the various departments of the Tanger Med Port Complex Harbor Master's Office in order to familiarize themselves with the operational practices of a world-class port hub.

At the end of this immersion, a closing ceremony will be organized with the presentation of certificates of participation to all beneficiaries.

Through this initiative, Tanger Med Engineering confirms its ability to transmit its port know-how and to



support the strengthening of the skills of African port authorities. This approach is part of TME's desire to share the expertise developed at Tanger Med and to contribute to the development of more efficient, safer, and more resilient ports on the African continent.

Among the flagship achievements is the mooring study, which illustrates the level of expertise mobilized by TME. Thanks to a modeling of ship behavior under various wind and swell conditions, this study confirmed an excellent level of berth operability as well as the appropriate sizing of the mooring equipment, with no major constraints identified.

Through this diverse range of missions, Tanger Med Engineering demonstrates its ability to mobilize multidisciplinary technical expertise to enhance port performance. By supporting Lomé Container Terminal in optimizing its infrastructure and operations,

Intended for third-year middle school students as well as second- and third-year high school students, this personalized learning platform has now established itself as a fully fledged driver of the academic path.

The consolidated figures since the program's launch illustrate this momentum: 3 312 beneficiaries spread across the 12 institutions in the province, an overall success rate of 70% on the platform's tests, and French accounting for 53.7% of learning time, followed closely by English (42.9%). Ibn Rushd High School in Bahraouiye leads in the volume of completed activities,



while Abdelkrim El Khattabi High School in Ksar Al Majaz stands out in the completion of placement tests.

To maintain this momentum, the Foundation and Altissia have provided

encouragement prizes—tablets and laptops—rewarding the most deserving students and teachers.

EARLY CHILDHOOD: FIVE PRESCHOOL PLAYGROUNDS DELIVERED IN VILLAGES ADJACENT TO TANGER MED PORT COMPLEX

Tanger Med Foundation has completed the first phase of its playground development and equipping program for preschools, a social project designed to reduce territorial disparities in access to educational leisure.

Five preschool units, spread across the villages surrounding Tanger Med Port Complex, are the beneficiaries: Al Houma, Ktama, Al Zahara, Ain Rmel,

and Oued Ghlala. Each now features a turn-key playground equipped with modern structures: slides, swings, spring riders, and multi-activity structures, complying with international safety standards.

Designed to accommodate groups of 25 to 30 children per unit, these spaces allow for simultaneous early childhood activities and offer toddlers



an environment in which to grow, play, and learn in complete serenity.

«ARKAN AL MAÂRIFA»: WHEN READING CORNERS TRANSFORM STUDENTS' RELATIONSHIP WITH BOOKS

Promoting reading and strengthening skills in schools: this is the goal of the "Arkan Al Maârifa" (Pillars of Knowledge) initiative, led by Tanger Med Foundation in partnership with the Afaaq Foundation and the Ministry of National Education. Three institutions hosted the project: Imlich Elementary School, Al Houma Elementary School, and Dar At-Taliba in Ksar Sghir.

After one year of deployment, the indicators reveal the scope of the initiative: 957 books carefully selected by age group, 655 direct student beneficiaries, and 2 810 loans recorded through a physical and digital lending register that empowers young readers.

In parallel, 27 training workshops brought together 270 participants



around active reading, summarization techniques, and public speaking, while 12 pedagogical and administrative staff members are dedicated to facilitating

and ensuring the long-term sustainability of these spaces.

«A BETTER VISION, A BETTER FUTURE»: 200 STUDENTS RECEIVE PRESCRIPTION GLASSES FROM TANGER MED FOUNDATION

In keeping with its commitment to school health, Tanger Med Foundation organized a mobile eye clinic for elementary and middle school students in the province of Fâh Anjra—its primary area of operation—which covers the municipalities of Ksar Sghir, Ksar Al Majaz, and Jouamaa.

Conducted in partnership with healthcare professionals, opticians, and local organizations, the campaign screened 460 students. Following this screening, nearly 200 children received prescription glasses tailored to their needs—a seemingly simple gesture, but one that is crucial to academic success: seeing better means reading better, learning better, and enjoying daily life more fully.

Under the theme "Better Vision, Better Future," this initiative demonstrates



Tanger Med Group's commitment—through its Foundation—to promoting equal opportunity by improving local

communities' access to healthcare and education.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING: FOUNDATION OPENS DOORS OF THE CAREER AND SKILLS CENTER FOR YOUTH

Tanger Med Foundation strengthens its commitment to youth employability through a partnership with OFPPT, centred on the Cité des Métiers et des Compétences (CMC) in Tangier, the region's new-generation vocational training and skills campus. This next-generation training centre spans 12 hectares and brings together nine vocational clusters, offering more than 80 specialised training programmes.

The partnership was launched with a series of awareness sessions involving around 50 middle and high school students, recent graduates and young people seeking career reorientation from across the province. It has since evolved into tangible training pathways, with nearly 40 young beneficiaries now enrolled in integrated programmes, including fast-fit vehicle maintenance



and e-commerce, with their tuition fees fully covered by the Foundation. To ensure equal access to vocational training, the Foundation also provides

transportation for beneficiaries from the most remote rural areas, removing distance as a barrier to skills development and professional integration.

2026 LALLA AL MOUTAÂOUINA AWARD: LOUJAINÉ COOPERATIVE HONORED WITH SUPPORT OF FOUNDATION

Women's economic empowerment took center stage on April 30, 2026, in Rabat, during the ceremony marking the 7th edition of the "Lalla Al Moutaâouina" national program, held as part of National Social and Solidarity Economy Week under the High Patronage of His Majesty King Mohammed VI. This year's edition recognized 29 women's cooperatives out of 144 that were shortlisted.

As a partner in the program, Tanger Med Foundation supports the Loujainé cooperative, based in Hjar Nhal, Tangier, which was founded to promote the use of seaweed in the production of natural



cosmetics. It has developed a line of skin care products that are available in local and regional markets and are now also available for purchase online.

Through this support, the Foundation reaffirms its long-standing commitment to women's cooperatives in the region, working to foster a social economy rooted in local communities.
